



PUBLIC POLICY SHORT LIST FOR:

CENTRO

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We strive to build access to human-centered, walkable, vibrant communities and spaces for all.

1. FUTURE TRANSIT EXPANSION

Study and implement future transit expansion beyond Centro's Better Bus Onondaga system redesign.

2. BETTER BUS STOPS

Provide more seating, shelters, and accessible sidewalk access.

3. IMPROVE LEGIBILITY OF BUS MAPS AND ROUTES

Improve legibility of bus maps and routes for an easier and more intuitive rider experience.

4. REDUCE TRAFFIC ON BUS ROUTES, SUCH AS WITH LANES & BUSWAYS

Utilize bus lanes and busways to bypass traffic, speed up routes, and reduce delays.

5. COORDINATE TRANSIT WITH HOUSING & ACTIVITY DENSITY

Support upzoning around transit stations, BRT stations, and bus stops. Support funding for housing & mixed uses around transit, & prioritize transit around current & future dense, walkable, mixed-use neighborhoods. Coordinate service, street networks, and the design of new developments with city, county, towns, and private businesses at locations of planned and/or desired future development.

6. BUS PRIORITY TRAFFIC LIGHTS

Expand bus priority traffic lights to more routes and allow BRT buses to change lights from red to green.

7. EXPAND AWARENESS OF CENTRO SERVICES

Expand public awareness of the benefits and extents of Centro services, and how to use Centro services, including navigating routes and tap to pay.
